AI AND SAFETY IN SYSTEMATIC REVIEW IN ROME

A main objective for AI and Safety in Systematic Review – Italy is for students to apply modern tools in Artificial Intelligence (AI) to safety, well-being and health. A second main objective is to provide an opportunity for students to explore the rich culture and historic sites of Italy. An additional objective is for students to remember and understand safe product and process design in the context of safety, prevention, well-being and health-related principles. Workshops and activities will emphasize and reinforce key principles. Students will also gain insight from identifying, organizing, analyzing and synthesizing metadata from articles and databases in early stages of a systematic review and reappraisal.
